

ONE HOUR MORRIS DOCUMENTARY FOR BBC ARTS

Libra Television is producing a one hour arts documentary, to be directed by filmmaker Richard Macer, about the Morris as it stands (or dances) in 2018.

We will be following several narratives including the history of the Morris and have been in touch with all three Morris organisations to ensure we include a broad perspective and background to the Morris in all its forms.

We hope to film at the JMO National Day of Dance so that we can capture and meet a variety of sides and styles of dance in a spectacular setting, which potentially could make the final documentary.

I'm seeking permission to film at the event and get consent from participating teams to allow us to film them dancing and possibly interview members should they wish.

I would imagine our focus will be on the adult sides rather than youth sides, however, if we can get permission to film under 16s also then that would be helpful.

Please note our filming shouldn't conflict with Blue Peter but we are happy to co-ordinate with them if you are concerned that this may be an issue.
